

TECHNICAL DATA

This product is fitted with an E14 (EU) or E12 (US) bulb fitting for the table version and E27 (EU) or E26 (US) bulb fitting for the floor version. HAY recommends using this product with frosted LED bulbs.

PAPER CUBE TABLE LAMP FITTING TYPE | LED E14 (EU) or LED E12 (US) POWER (W) | 5-8W COLOUR TEMPERATURE | Warm white.

PAPER CUBE FLOOR LAMP FITTING TYPE | LED E27 (EU) or LED E26 (US) POWER (W) | 8-15W COLOUR TEMPERATURE | Warm white.



Do not use wet or damp cloths for cleaning and maintaining the shade. Please use a dry, lint-free cloth or duster to remove any dirt.








Paper Shade



Legs




US Plug




EU Plug

UK converter


Unpack all the components and check that you have received all the components listed. Begin by unfolding the paper shade, following the illustrations below. Then place it upside down on a flat, clean surface.




Before assembling the shade and dowel connector, begin by screwing the bulb into the bulb holder. For recommended bulbs, please refer to the technical data specification on first page. Carefully open the paper shade and insert the bulb so it is inside the paper shade. Move to the next step to see how you clip in the wooden dowels.




Locate the two longer dowels and clip them, one at a time, into the slots in the middle of the dowel connector as pictured below.




Repeat with the two smaller dowels, and clip them into the slots on the bottom of the dowel connector, as pictured below. This will ensure the shade is completely stable.




Carefully pinch the top edge of the shade's corners and insert the legs. Then flip the lamp over to a standing position. Make sure that the legs are all the way in the hems. For the floor version, the wooden legs are longer.



Gently adjust the Paper Cube shade by pulling both the diagonal sides of the lamp shade. If the lamp is not straight, adjust the legs by pulling them slightly outwards to make the lamp stand straighter.




Plug in the cable and the lamp is ready to use.



Please note that for UK customers, the lamp will come supplied with a pre-mounted UK converter. The UK converter will be mounted over the existing EU plug, so the lamp is compatible and ready for use with UK sockets.

If not pre-mounted, please follow the below instruction.

Insert the EU plug into the converter provided. Close the converter over the EU plug with the pins secured in the internal spring clip contacts. Screw the converter together to ensure the UK plug is secure.
